# Memoandum of Agreement

made the Fifth day of January One thousand  
eight hundred and ninety one Between Francis  
Edward Roberts of the City of Chester Solicitor  
and Charles Berry Phillips of the same  
place Retired Merchant Captain of the one part  
and Samuel Pope of Hafod y Bryn Blanbedr  
in the County of Merioneth Esquire D.C. of the other  
part Whereas a certain Limited Company known  
as The Dryffyn Mining Company has during the  
past two years and upwards been engaged in &  
searching for getting and selling Manganese Ore  
in and from certain of the lands specified in the  
Second Schedule hereto and has also arranged to  
take Leases or Take Notes of other of such lands for  
the purposes aforesaid the nominal capital of such  
Company consisting of five thousand pounds in five  
thousand shares of one pound each of which shares  
three thousand and twenty five only have been  
issued and the same are now held by the several  
persons named in the First Column of the First  
Schedule hereto And whereas the said Samuel  
Pope has agreed for the purchase of the said  
three thousand and twenty five shares in manner  
hereinafter mentioned Now it is witnessed  
that the said Francis Edward Roberts and  
Charles Berry Phillips (hereinafter sometimes called  
the Vendors) for and on behalf of the several  
Shareholders in the said Company agree that such  
several Shareholders shall transfer and sell to the  
said Samuel Pope (hereinafter sometimes called the  
Purchaser) or his Nominees and the said Samuel  
Pope agrees to purchase All and singular the

said Company so issued as aforesaid The purchase money for such shares to be the sum of Two thousand two hundred pounds The purchase to be completed on or before the First day of March now next All profits arising from works previous to the day of the date hereof shall belong to the Vendors on behalf of the said Shareholders all disbursements and liabilities shall be borne and discharged by them to that date All ores gotten previous to such date to belong to the Vendors on behalf of such Shareholders and to be realized at their expense All horses (if any) carts tools plant and machinery belonging to the Company as on the day of date hereof to become the property of the Purchaser who shall have the right to use the same for his own benefit and that of his nominees as from such date bearing and discharging all expenses outlay and liabilities which may be incurred as from that date excepting expense of realizing the said stock of ores as aforesaid.

The said Vendors on behalf of the Shareholder undertake and agree to pay and discharge out of assets of the Company all liabilities in respect of salaries wages dead-rents royalties and other expenditure to the said Fifth day of January and the Purchaser agrees to bear pay and discharge all such claims as from that date.

All Leases Take Notes and Agreements held by or on behalf of the Company to be transferred to the Purchaser or his nominees. The Purchaser to bear all costs incident to such transfers or to the transfers of the said shares agreed to be sold and purchased as aforesaid. The purchaser also to bear and pay all debts

costs incident to any Leases or Take Notes now  
in course of negotiation -

The said Charles Berry Phillips to execute  
to the Purchaser a Release of all claims past  
and future in respect of Royalty on ores gotten  
or to be gotten.
